

USF/SFCM Intensive English Program - Summer 2017

The San Francisco Conservatory of Music offers a Summer English Intensive program, through The University of San Francisco, for non-native speakers. This program is designed for students who would like to start a degree at SFCM in the fall semester but need to improve their English language skills before doing so. The program is also appropriate for international students who wish to refresh their English language skills in the United States before starting a degree program at SFCM.

In addition to intensive ESL coursework at The University of San Francisco, students in the Summer English Intensive Program, will incorporate the study of music into their summer experience.

In 2017, this program runs from July 3 until August 11. Move-in to Panoramic student housing is Thursday, June 29 or Friday, June 30, and details will be emailed to students that are attending. Please note that elements of the program such as tuition and health insurance may be billed to student from USF while other elements such as housing will be billed by SFCM.

Program Features:

- Small classes and individual attention
- 25 hours of English instruction per week
- TOEFL workshops
- Extra-curricular activities in the San Francisco Bay Area
- Access to USF and SFCM facilities, practice rooms, resources, events
- Dedicated faculty who hold master's and doctoral degrees
- Housing option at the Panoramic, SFCM's high-rise residence for students
